#### Major Employers in the Region

This month we are focussing on the Chemical Process industry with an overview of its importance to the North East Economy and potential opportunities for employment.

The North East of England Process Industry Cluster (**NEPIC**) was created and is owned by its member companies to represent the companies and supply chain of the Process Industries in the region.



NEPIC is an organisation that represents 500 Pharmaceutical, Biotechnology, Speciality, Polymer & Rubber, Petrochemical & Commodity Chemical companies based in North East England. Furthermore, there are at least an equal number of companies in the supply chain of these industries based in this region making this a major economic Cluster. The combined economic power of NEPIC companies and their importance to North East England cannot be over emphasised.

They generate in excess of £10bn of sales and represent 30% of the regions industrial base, employing about **40,000 people** directly and impacting indirectly on the income of a further **280,000**. NEPIC companies have significant presence in all sub regions of North East England - Northumberland, Tyne & Wear, Durham and Teesside.

NEPIC member companies are currently investing a further £7bn into the region by 2015. This expansion, together with the current demographics within the sector requires the industry to attract some 16,000 new employees into the sector. Through NEPIC the regions process industry companies are working to promote the attractiveness of this sector as a career opportunity and develop new routes to obtain a career in this well paid sector.

### Regional Business News

A brief round-up of all the most important stories of regional business information for the North East



**Cleveland Cable Company** The owner of the UK's biggest cable company says that the construction sector is at "a 30 year low and there is nothing to be optimistic about in the current market" Alistair Powell owner and MD of Middlesbrough based Cleveland Cable Company has called on the government to take steps to prevent debt which is a major headache for large businesses, company revenues were down by 15%.



A Start-up company is hoping to create hundreds of jobs. North East firm Inova Power is developing a system to extend how far electric vehicles can travel making them more commercially viable. They are working with a consortium of companies and Sunderland University over the next 12 months to put the technology into the new generation of electric cars.



**Special cable system pays off for Tekmar Darlington** Subsea specialist engineering firm Tekmar has seen growth treble following its success with patented wind farm technology. Last year it won 90% of all European subsea cabling contracts and is set to see profits and expansion increase again over the next year. It has doubled its work force and moved to a purpose built factory in Darlington.



A TCP Investment plan New owner of Teesside Cast Products SSI has pledged over £600M investment over the next 2 years. It hopes to bring in 800 workers on top of the existing 700 employees and aims to invest £91M to improve production to 3.5 million tonnes of steel slab per year.



The government has given the green light to £4.5Bn deal that will see trains manufactured in Newton Aycliffe County Durham with the creation of thousands of jobs. Japanese giant Hitachi will create 500 jobs initially with thousands more in the supply chain. The first trains will roll out in 2016.



Sunderland software centre set to bring jobs to the city. 160 jobs are to be created in the city with accommodation for up to 60 software businesses. The 53,000sq ft centre built in partnership with the city council one North East and private software companies is designed to give a physical home to the business as well as attracting visitors through an exhibition space that highlights how software affects our everyday lives.
