How do I access the Programme?

Are you leaving the Service after less than 4 years?

You should be informed about the programme by your Unit Briefing Officer as part of the discharge process, and given the opportunity to register for the programme via JPA or Opt-In form.

As soon as you're discharged, you'll have either a face-to-face or telephone meeting with a member of the CTP Future Horizons team, where we'll discuss how we can best support you.

Royal British Legion Employment Support Grant

An employment grant is available to ex-serving personnel and their families, specifically those who are unemployed or under-employed. The two types of grant are:

A Training, Travel, Accommodation and Equipment Grant, capped at £1,000.

A Licences Grant, used to fund a professional licence that is needed for your work; for example, a Security Industry Authority (SIA) licence capped at £250.
