Regional Business News

A brief round-up of all the most important stories of regional business information for the North West and North Wales



on the road to a greener future

HAULIER Abbey Logistics - The company, which employs 250 people from its Bootle base, recently rebranded from Abbey Road Tanks to Abbey Logistics Group to better reflect the range of services on offer and has set out a green agenda with all vehicles bearing the slogan "on the road to a greener future". Although it is not recruiting drivers at the moment, the company does hold on file completed application forms, and will contact applicants as and when vacancies arise. A year after a Scottish specialist contractor opened a site on Knowsley Business Park, creating 80 jobs, it has announced expansion plans that will lead to the recruitment of a further 40 staff.

Paisley-based IQA Group provides a variety of services, including electrical internal mains, cable jointing, building maintenance and civil works on behalf of large companies, such as Merseyside electricity provider Scottish Power.

The jobs boost comes as the firm launches a sister company, Innovo Energy, which is a renewable energy business that will deliver sustainable and

renewable energy to homes and premises across the UK.

A total of 80 people were recruited, including office staff, electricians and cable jointers, and the company has recently invested in a fleet of 27 new vans. Across its three sites, IQA, headed by recently appointed managing director Gregory Addison- Smyth, employs 250 people.



More than 200 jobs are under threat in Wirral after food manufacturer Tulip announced plans to close a factory. Tulip announced it was consulting with staff over plans to close its loss making Transfoods plant in Abbey Street, Birkenhead. The company would now talk to staff to see if it could find any alternative work for them.

North West Regional Overview

Business leaders across the North West are united in their belief that confidence in the economy is up, bank lending will increase this year and that companies will experience growth over the next 12 months. Despite the challenges of recent months, an overwhelming majority of people (89%) still believe that the North West is a good place to do business, indicating that regional passion has not been dampened by the recession.

However, opinion around how much better the North West economy fares in relation to the rest of the UK is more divided, with only 45% believing the North West is better than the rest of the UK, 28% thinking it is the same and 17% thinking that it is worse. This would suggest that whilst businesses are positive about the region's business assets, they are comparatively sombre about its overall economic position in the UK.

By far, the greatest issue stated as hampering the region's potential is its transport and infrastructure. 28% of respondents cited this as their main concern, followed by lack of inward investment (24%), skills/training (17%), business support (15%) and regeneration (7%).

Business attitudes

Over the past 18 months, the global economy has gone through unprecedented challenges and North West businesses have not been immune from these. Key sectors including construction, manufacturing and financial services have all suffered high profile difficulties and redundancies across the region, making 2012 a challenging year for all.



North Wales: For the 12 months ending December 2011 there were 4,100 new Jobcentre vacancy notifications in North Wales, up by 600 or 17 per cent over the previous 12 months(1) (Wales down 2 per cent and GB down 1 per cent).

- All 6 authorities within North Wales had increases, with the Isle of Anglesey having the largest percentage increase (up 35 per cent) and Denbighshire the smallest (up 10 per cent).
- The stock of unfilled vacancies in North Wales was down 300 or 8 per cent between December 2010 and December 2011, compared to a 2 per cent increase for Wales as a whole and a 1 per cent fall for GB.
- 2 of the 6 local authorities within North Wales experienced increases over this period with the Flintshire having the largest percentage increase (up 8 per cent). The remaining 4 authorities had falls over this period with Denbighshire having the largest percentage fall, down 38 per cent.
