## Regional Business News

A brief round-up of all the most important stories of business information for the South Wales and South West England regions

### Queue for Christmas post jobs sets record

The Royal Mail has received a record 110,000 applications across the UK for 18,000 seasonal workers. The temporary employees have already started working in Royal Mail locations across the UK to help the 130,000 permanent postmen and women deal with the expected two billion Christmas items. Last year the total number of applications was 70,000

### Massive growth in renewable energy in Wales will boost jobs

Wales is behind other parts of the UK in its development of renewable energy sources according to an industry specialist. Renewable energy developers in Wales have so far this financial year announced investment worth £779.8m with the potential to create 1,400 jobs. The director of Bridgend based Infinite Energy said Wales needed to maximise the financial and environmental benefits of home-grown energy. He stated that the turbine applications in Wales, compared with Scotland, are way behind, where they have hundreds pending whereas Wales only has a handful. Manufacturers Mabey Bridge, based in Chepstow (registered with the CTP) recently announced a £38m state-of-the-art wind turbine factory in south Wales which created in excess of 200 jobs.

This is a breakdown of investment in Wales this financial year:

Gwynt y Mor wind farm; Mabey Bridge wind turbine tower manufacturer; Port of Mostyn, 100 jobs in north Wales; Albion Ventures & Infinite Energy investment in a single wind turbine site; Anglesey Aluminium Metals investment in a biomass plant; Dwr Cymru (Welsh Water) investment in a new renewables facility; S&C Electric investment in Swansea; EcoPellets Ltd investment in a planned biomass plant.

### South West Region News

Unemployment in the West Country has hit a 17-year high. In Devon and Cornwall, the number of people of working age claiming Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) increased by 960 last month to 29,555. In

Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly the figure was 9,625 (up 650 on the month), Devon 9,805 (up 315) and Torbay 3,445 (up 135). Plymouth bucked the trend with 115 fewer people on JSA, or 6,680 people in total. The region's "claimant count" is at its highest level since February last year. It means just over 3 per cent of the region's working population are claiming JSA – at the height of the recession it was just below 3.5 per cent.

In the greater South West, 177,000 are out of work, figures revealed yesterday, an increase of 2,000 in the three months to October. It means 6.6 per cent of the working population in the region are out of work. The rate is better than most other parts of the UK; however an analysis of official figures by the GMB union shows the South West has seen the biggest proportion of public sector job losses since the general election. There are now 12 public sector workers losing their jobs for every new post which is created in the private sector.

Of more than 370,000 jobs gone since May last year, 54,000 have been in the South West.

The Government has recently pumped millions into high-profile jobs boosting schemes in the region – including a space exploration centre at Goonhilly Earth Station near Hayle, West Cornwall, and a Princess Yachts factory in Plymouth.

UNEMPLOYED people in Plymouth, aged over 50, are set to benefit from a new service to help them get back to work. The library service, Get SET 50, is being launched by Plymouth City Council and Jobcentre Plus to offer practical support in Devonport, Efford, Southway and Plympton libraries. Professional careers advisors from Careers South West, tutors from Plymouth Adult and Community Learning service and trained library staff will be involved with the service. Jobseekers will benefit from interviews to find out their training needs, free internet access and help to find information about jobs and benefits. A series of free, half day workshops including CV writing, preparing for work, using Word and mock interviews are also on offer.

## Job Losses in the region



The latest quarterly unemployment figures saw a rise of 14,000 in **Wales** to 133,000 between August and October 2011 – a rate of 9.4%, one of the highest in the UK.

**DVLA Swansea** – Nearly 80 jobs are to be at risk as the DVLA revealed it was to close three regional offices in Wales under plans to centralise operations at its Swansea headquarters.



**Norgine Pharmaceuticals Ltd**, Hengoed, Caerphilly County has announced 36 job losses. The company said there had been a 'significant decrease' in demand for some of its products, and blamed the global economy and increasing use of generic copies of brands. It said it remained committed to the factory, which employs 350 workers.

**ADMINISTRATORS** have confirmed that two Torbay hotels have closed with the loss of 25 jobs. Bute Court Hotel in Belgrave Road, Torquay, and the Torbay Court Hotel in Steartfield Road, Paignton have both closed.

**Jobs created at ship repair firm – Swansea Drydocks (SDL)**, a ship repair and recycling company could create about 80 jobs. The Environment Agency has given an indication that it will grant an operating permit for its new operation in Swansea. The company has already started to interview Technical Managers and will soon start to advertise for other staff.



**SWALEC** – Smart Energy Centre to create 250 jobs in south Wales with the opening of a new £7m energy training centre. Based in Treforest, Rhondda Cynon Taf, the company will receive £2m in Welsh government funds. Business Minister Edwina Hart said the centre would offer “excellent training and employment opportunities.” It is envisaged the centre will train staff from Wales and the rest of the UK in new ‘green’ technologies. It will take about six months to complete. SWALEC, part of Scottish & Southern Energy (SSE) employs more than 2,000 people in Wales.



**Sunshine Care** A PLYMOUTH care company wants to recruit 110 people in the next two months. Family-run Sunshine Care said it needs more workers due to the "significant expansion" of its home care services in Plymouth and the South West. It has also seen growth in its dementia care and end-of-life care services. Sunshine Care said it needs to recruit 85 new care and support workers, and, in addition, 25 more nursing agency staff are required to cater for the growth in demand for complex care and 24-hour live-in care services. These will be recruited over the next few weeks, the firm said.

**DEVON & Somerset Fire & Rescue Service** is urgently seeking to recruit retained firefighters who will be available for calls during the daytime in Moretonhampstead and Chagford. In the event of additional firefighters not being found, there may be occasions in the future when appliances from other stations have to attend incidents in the towns. Group manager Robbie Woods said: "Retained firefighters are normal people who live or work in the community. "They are builders, housewives, postal workers and shopkeepers – in fact they come from all and every walk of life. The only thing they have in common is that they have all decided to put something back into the community by becoming trained as firefighters. "We know that there are many more women that are capable of becoming firefighters who are reluctant to put themselves forward. Most people believe that the physical strength required to be a firefighter is greater than it actually is. "Now it is the firefighters themselves that need your help, there simply aren't enough of them and there is a real shortage of new volunteers." Applicants must be at least 18 and physically fit. They need to be available Monday-Friday and in particular during the daytime. Successful applicants will have a chance to attend first-aid and LGV driving courses. Anyone interested should come to a recruitment evening on Wednesday, January 25, at Chagford Fire Station from 7pm to 9pm. Staff will give information on the role of firefighters.

**Whitbread** says its £13 million investment plans will create 122 new jobs in Devon. It is set to open a new Beefeater Grill restaurant and Premier Inn hotel in Newton Abbott in January and a further Beefeater Grill restaurant and hotel in Paignton, in March. **Wolf Minerals** Work will begin in January on a £110 million project to restart tungsten mining at Hemerdon, near Plymouth. Australian mining firm Wolf Minerals has confirmed that the project will start in the New Year and has announced that Bardon Contracting has been awarded the tender to build a 600 metre link road between Lee Moor Road and West Park Hill, in Plympton. Hemerdon has the fourth largest tungsten resource in the world and the study found that mining and processing would be viable for at least the next ten years. Mining at Hemerdon would be opencast and would involve a pit measuring 800m by 500m by 200m, with waste material dumped north of the pit on Crownhill Down next to the Imerys china clay operations. Wolf expects the mine to employ 150 to 200 people during construction, with 230 employed when it
