Regional Business News

A brief round-up of all the most important stories of business information for the South Wales and South West England regions

Cardiff Airport will be included in an extended St Athan Enterprise Zone. Two of the five initial enterprise zones are in south east Wales – at St Athan and the Cardiff Central Business District. In south west Wales there will be another at the Haven Waterway in Pembrokeshire.

Contracts have been awarded for the Welsh Government's £17m Business Start-Up service, which could create 6,500 new jobs in the next three years.

The scheme will help to establish 2,000 new-growth businesses across Wales.

Green Investment Bank – a robust bid to make Cardiff the home of the new Green Investment Bank has been submitted by the Welsh Government.

Wales has already attracted a significant number of internationally known businesses with strong green economic credentials and investment in Cardiff, which has transformed the city and Cardiff Bay into one of the most exciting and dynamic capital cities in Europe. The bank would have a guaranteed £3bn from the Treasury as initial capital.

Jobless number in Wales – The number of people out of work in Wales stood at 130,000 during the previous three months.

According to unemployment data 9% of 16 to 64 year olds are unemployed in Wales. This compares to 8.6% across the rest of the UK. Overall the number of jobless is reducing, however the number of jobless 18 to 24 year olds has increased to 13% a total of 26,200.

Solar Panel installations – More than 2,000 families in south Wales have had their electricity bills slashed due to an £8m solar panel installation project across the region. The regions of Cardiff, Swansea, Newport and south Wales Valleys social housing tenants have benefited. Confusion regarding the feed-in-tariffs has slowed down expansion with the rate set to be reduced from 43p to 21p from March 2012.

Service leavers looking to gain employment in this market must gain the MCS (Microgeneration Certification Scheme) in order to become a qualified PV installer. However, there are more than 2,000 registered MCS qualified engineers in Wales already.

The majority although qualified, don't have enough work to rely on this business alone.

More than 100 major UK businesses have signed up to a government initiative that proposes asking for CVs without the name or the school details of candidates in order to remove the risk of discrimination during the application process. Firms such as Tesco, Barclays and Coca-Cola have agreed to the Government's Business Compact, which requires them to recruit "fairly and without discrimination" by using application forms that don't allow candidates to be screened out due to the school they went to or their ethnicity.

The agreement adds that this could be done through "name-blank" and "school-blank" applications, as both of these fields could result in the candidate facing discrimination during the hiring process.

Other elements of the agreement include advertising work experience placements to people of different backgrounds online and in schools, instead of giving places to "informal contacts", and providing financial support or paying the national minimum wage to interns.

Cornwall Unemployment News

The number of unemployed people in Cornwall has risen slightly by 589, representing 3.1% of the working population (ONS). More people are turning to starting up their own business, with the number of start up business growing by more than 20% in the past 2 years. These small businesses are potentially the large employers of tomorrow.

Job Losses in the region



Armed Forces facing an additional 4,200 job losses in new MoD cuts. Including 400 Gurkhas, the army will lose up to 2,900 soldiers, the RAF 1,000 and the RN 300. These redundancies will exacerbate the problems for service leavers returning to Wales due to the already tough job market.



Lloyds Banking Group in Wales has announced plans to axe 200 jobs as part of a major reorganisation. Cardiff will see 170 job losses, 20 in Newport, the remainder in Swansea.



Swansea Council has shed 400 jobs since 2009 saving an estimated £10m. The authority has warned that another 100 posts will have to go in the next financial year – April 2012 onwards



Peacocks Group the Welsh based clothing group has gone into administration. Peacocks employs around 1,000 people in south Wales with many more across the UK. Although the company made an operating profit of £27m last year, its underlying debts in excess of £400m, which were inherited during a management buyout in 2006, and has been unable to re-finance, has resulted in

administration. There are currently four major bidders for the group. Over 200 head office staff based in Cardiff have already left the company.







Bonmarché which was part of the **Peacocks Group** also went into administration. An immediate buy-out by private equity group Sun European Partners has saved the company, however there is still a threat of 1,400 redundancies.

Job creations in the region

The co-operative

The Co-operative Group is to recruit 800 new apprentices this year, twice as many as in 2011. They will be based in one of its businesses ranging from food and pharmacy to farming and funerals. The company's £9m apprenticeship academy is on track to provide 2,000 places for young people by 2014. It is not clear how many opportunities will be based in Wales.

The incinerator still needs to gain an operational licence from the Environment Agency before it begins operating, scheduled to be in November 2014. 

Through the partnership with Blue Light, Avon and Somerset Police anticipate achieving substantial savings from this approved amount. Over the life of the contract savings of over £60m are expected.

Led by Bilfinger Berger Project Investments and comprising Miller Construction and Cofely, the consortium will design, build, finance and operate a new operational base, two custody and crime investigation centres, two police stations and a tri-force firearms training centre. An allocation of over £129million of PFI credits will be made by HM Treasury in order to deliver this ambitious programme.

The new Somerset operations base will be located at Express Park, Bridgwater and two custody and crime investigation centres will be built at 90 Gloucester Road, Patchway, and Ashmead Road, Keynsham. This increased capacity to hold criminals will support Avon and Somerset Police's drive to protect local communities by improving the detection of crimes and bringing more offenders to justice. The new facilities will provide comfortable and discrete units for victims and witnesses of crime and a flexible, modern, sustainable working environment for our staff.
