Formula 1-inspired aircraft seat maker Mirus snaps up \$100m contract with Air Asia



Hingham-based Mirus will launch production in August, with the first of more than 50,000 seats being delivered to the budget airline's city-hopping aircraft in September. For Mirus, which received a £360,000 New Anglia Local Enterprise Partnership grant in December, it signals the start of what chief executive Phil Hall said was "long overdue shake-up" of the industry. Mr Hall, who previously worked as a design engineer in Formula 1, said: "Our customer base is long overdue a bit of a shake-up. Mirus currently employs 23 people, and will be recruiting between 15 to 20 people in the run up to the launch of production. At capacity, Mr Halls said the factory would employ between 100 and 120 people. [Read more.](#)

Huge new retail park springing up on Norwich ring road next to Sweet Briar



The Sweet Briar Park development is starting to take shape on fields the size of 15 football pitches on the A140 outer ring road, next to the present Sweet Briar Retail Park, on the edge of Norwich. Adrian Fennell, of Roche, which is acting as joint agents for the development with Bidwells, said: "It is great to see so much interest in this prime development opportunity.

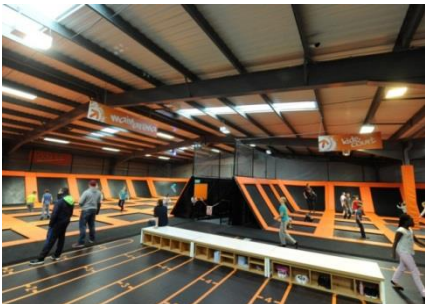
"The location is key. It's right on the ring road and it's very rare to get a development in a location like this. This sort of opportunity does not come up very often." He said he expected the park to end up being a mix of retail and showrooms and said each development would need to secure planning permission. [Read more.](#)

Siemens confirms it will supply turbines for East Anglia ONE windfarm



A huge economic boost for the east coast took another step closer after global engineering company Siemens confirmed it would supply the turbines for a major windfarm project. It will manufacture the 75-metre long turbine blades in its new factory in Hull before investing £5million in Great Yarmouth Harbour, which will act as the pre-assembly port for the installation of the turbines. It will help to support many of the 3,000 jobs that the project aims to create during construction. [Read more.](#)

Bounce trampoline centre set to take over B&Q store at Anglia Retail Park in Ipswich when it closes this summer



Bounce, which is already up and running in Milton Keynes, have confirmed they are taking over 50,000sq ft of the B&Q store at the Anglia Retail Park near Whitehouse which is due to close this summer. It looks set to be a major attraction and bring many visitors, and create new jobs, for the town. "It will generate much needed footfall on the park which we are confident will attract further new retailers and improve the tenant mix, eventually creating close to 300 new jobs as well as supporting a variety of local businesses."

New centre to create hundreds more jobs



Hundreds of new jobs will be available within months at Colchester's creative business centre. The six month countdown has begun before the transformation from converted police station and former night club in Queen Street to a home for 43 businesses is complete. The Creative Business Centre will facilitate flexible working alongside spaces for meetings, networking, business incubation and showcases - with approximately 20,000 sq. ft. of lettable space. There will be a restaurant and café on the ground floor. Importantly for digital and software businesses, the Creative Business Centre will have state-of-the-art connectivity, provided as a benefit of the Council's on-going project to deploy ultra-fast fibre optic infrastructure to the town centre.
