### Abbott to recruit more than 150 at Witney Factory



Pharmaceutical firm Abbott is recruiting more than 150 people to work at its UK diabetes care manufacturing hub in Witney, Oxfordshire, over the next 18 months. The Witney factory employs around 650 people, who research, develop and manufacture glucose monitoring products used by patients and healthcare professionals around the world. In a statement the firm said it is looking to recruit employees new to the workforce as well as "seasoned" professionals with relevant skills to work across these areas Read More



### Mountjoy sign new £60m contract with Portsmouth City Council



The familiar dark blue vans will be seen around the city for at least another six years after the contract was signed by Portsmouth City Council. Mountjoy, which has more than 100 tradesmen, carries out building repairs and maintenance, and refurbish vacant properties in Landport, Buckland, Somerstown and Portsea areas. Mountjoy was founded in 1992 by Chris Howells. It has more than 300 employees and covers London and the south east. It has an annual turnover of £30m. Read More

### Trant Engineering wins £55 million contract to upgrade power plant



A Hampshire firm has won a £55 million government contract to upgrade a power plant vital for the defence of the Falkland Islands. Trant Engineering, based in Totton, will carry out the work at power station, boiler house and district heating system at the Mount Pleasant RAF base. The contract, the biggest in Trant's history, was agreed between the firm and the Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO). It comes after Defence Secretary Michael Fallon visited the Falklands in February and is part of £180 million investment over the next decade to modernise the military infrastructure on the islands. ### £66m invested in renewable energy projects in Hampshire



Independent energy entrepreneurs in Hampshire invested in 14 new renewable projects with a total 70MW of capacity in 2015. The county has now seen £66 million invested in 125 projects with a total 371MW, supplying three per cent of independent renewable power in the UK, putting it in the top 10 counties for independent energy entrepreneurs. As previously reported Hampshire ranks third in I solar power output from solar farms and panels on private roofs. Nationally energy entrepreneurs outside the traditional electricity supply sector invested more than £376 million in more than 100 commercial-scale projects during 2015, adding 2.4GW of new renewable capacity across the UK. ### Hampshire storage firm keeps getting bigger



Looking after other people's stuff is a profitable business. Hampshire-based self-storage company, Lok'nStore, has posted record profits as it continues to expand across the south. The company has built a portfolio of 26 distinctive orange-clad stores, and has just opened a new one in Millbrook. Lok'nStore offers self-storage facilities to individuals and businesses and currently has more than 8,000 customers. The company has reported an occupancy increase (likefor-like) of nearly three per cent on the previous year, resulting in a 4.7 per cent increase in group revenue and a 155.5 per cent increase in profits for the six months to January 31, 2016. Barely a year after turning his home brewing hobby into a business, Steve Farrell has seen his beer win awards – and a glass of it find its way into the hands of the prime minister. Eight Arch Brewing Company takes its name from the arches of Julian's Bridge in Wimborne, a short distance from the company's base. Steve set it up after his family closed their business, the Poole transport company Farsons. "I kind of thought I would take over from my father running the transport company, but I had been bitten by the brewing bug," he said. Read More
