Attend this course to learn how to:

- Ensure your organisations meet their responsibilities under Health and Safety and Environmental Management.
- Carry out risk assessments of most low risk workplaces and identify the range of protective and preventative measures required.
- Undertake effective safety and environmental inspections.
- Ensure that workplace activities under their control are undertaken safely.
- Manage environmental issues and the means by which they can be controlled.
- Provide detailed advice on Health & Safety, fire and environmental issues in line with current legislation and HSE guidance.



Programme Structure

This is an **intensive 5 week course** (not consecutive) which is built up of group tuition, practical inspections and written assessments. The syllabus is based on National Occupational Standards in Health and Safety and Environmental Management at SQA Level 6. Significant out of hours study will be required which you may want to keep in mind reference Service Accommodation.

Within this 26 day period you will be required to take part in the following elements:

NEBOSH General Certificate

- Management of health & safety
- Controlling workplace hazards
- Health and safety practical application

NEBOSH Fire Safety Certificate

- Fire Safety and Risk Management
- Practical Fire Risk Assessment.

NEBOSH Environmental Certificate

- Management and control of environmental hazards.
- Environmental practical application.

At the end of **each module**, you will sit an exam and submit a written practical assignment based on a site inspection completed during the module.

Upon successful completion of the course, exams and written assignments you will be awarded globally recognised qualifications. You will be awarded a certificate for each unit within each module, upon passing all the units for each module you will receive overall certification for that module.

Who is the course for?

These NEBOSH National Certificates are aimed at Supervisors and Managers within any industry who are required to ensure that activities under their control are undertaken safely. It is likely to prove useful for those concerned with the management of buildings, people and processes.

Employment Opportunities

There are considerable worldwide employment opportunities for those who hold a NEBOSH qualification in a wide variety of sectors including Construction, Energy and Renewables, Transport and Logistics and Facilities Management holding positions such as Health and Safety Officer, Supervisor, Manager and Consultant.

What support will I receive?

This course is delivered by specialist tutors in the field of Health and safety, fire safety and environmental issues. You will be provided with pre-course support and mentoring via email or telephone if required.

- Books are purchased as part of the course fees and will be provided for each module on your first day
- Off site visits will be arranged for you to utilise to complete your practical assignments

Further Study

Those who complete the course can add to their portfolio with additional industry specific qualifications such as the NEBOSH Certificate in Construction. Please note that some additional modules will require you to have passed the NEBOSH General Certificate Module as a core module.
