Who is the course for?

- ♦ The course is suitable for all Service personnel, but is particularly suitable for those with supervisory experience or responsibilities in a Health and Safety environment.
- ♦ For managers, supervisors and staff who need a broad understanding of Health and Safety issues.
 - ♦ The General Certificate helps individuals to manage workplace risks effectively.
 - ♦ The Fire Certificate is for those with or aspiring to hold Fire Safety responsibilities in the workplace.
 - ♦ The Construction Certificate is for those with or aspiring to hold responsibilities under the Construction Design and Management Regulations 2015.
- ♦ **NEBOSH qualifications are increasingly essential for those looking for employment in the Health and Safety sector.**



Course Structure

NEBOSH General Certificate

- ♦ Management of Health and Safety (NGC1) – *common element of all 3 qualifications*
- ♦ Controlling Workplace Hazards (GC2)
- ♦ Health and Safety Practical Application (GC3)
- ✓ 15 days duration
- ✓ Two 2 hour written examinations and workplace based practical examination

NEBOSH Fire Certificate

- ♦ Fire Safety and Risk Management (FC1)
- ♦ Practical Fire Risk Assessment (FC2)
- ✓ 5 days duration
- ✓ One 2 hour written examination and a workplace based practical examination

NEBOSH Construction Certificate

- ♦ Managing and Controlling Hazards in Construction Activities (CC1)
- ♦ Construction Health and Safety Practical Application (CC2)
- ✓ 7 days duration
- ✓ One 2 hour written examination and a risk assessment practical examination

What support will I receive?

- ◆ Over 3 modules, 27 days of classroom based learning supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course.
- ◆ All students are issued with:
 - ◆ An Introduction to Health and Safety at Work (latest edition)
 - ◆ An Introduction to Health and Safety in Construction (latest edition)
 - ◆ NEBOSH Fire Safety and Risk Assessment (by the Fire Protection Authority)
- ◆ NEBOSH General's companion revision guide is issued on a loan basis for the course duration to assist with exam preparation.



Further Study

Other NEBOSH and related Health and Safety courses offered by CTP include:

- ◆ Combined NEBOSH SHEF Practitioner (including Fire and Environmental Certificates)
- ◆ NEBOSH Technical Certificate in Oil and Gas Operational Safety
- ◆ Health and Safety Lead Auditor (OHSAS 18001)

Students could also consider studying NEBOSH Diploma level qualifications to deepen their Health and Safety knowledge further.

Employment Opportunities

- ◆ Once a student has attended and passed all three courses they are deemed to be a competent Health and Safety Practitioner in each of the three fields. All companies with more than five employees must have a designated competent person for Health and Safety.
- ◆ The NEBOSH General Certificate is accepted by the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) in meeting the academic requirements of their Technician (TechIOSH) grade. Those not currently practising can use the qualification to apply for Associate membership instead.
- ◆ NEBOSH certificates are widely recognised and can be used to obtain first line management Health and Safety roles across a wide range of industry sectors.



Course Fees and How to Fund



The course is Non-Contract Funded and therefore Service leavers are required to fund the course before attendance.

Exam Fees: £354.20

Total cost: £2,348.05
