Who is the course for?

- The aim of the course is to equip Service leavers planning to start their own business with the knowledge and confidence to take their idea forward from planning to launch.
- This course is for anyone wanting to explore starting their own business or enterprise. There are no formal pre-requisites; just a good idea and plenty of enthusiasm!
- To see if Self-employment is right for you, participants are advised to attend a CTP Self Employment Awareness workshop before undertaking the course.

What study support will I receive?

The course takes place over 2 days at the Resettlement Training Centre in Aldershot. You will receive:

- Experienced tutors with knowledge of military and self-employment
- Case studies of Service leavers who have gone on to start successful businesses
- Knowledge and expertise to develop your own business plan
- Clear direction on next steps to achieve your goal
- Post course support at specific times following your training

Course Fees and Funding

The total cost of the course is £312 including VAT.

Service leavers may choose to fund the course using a combination of IRTC grant and Standard Learning Credits.
