Who is the course for?

- This course is for Service leavers who have management experience and wish to pursue a career as a Project Manager.

Note: this course requires prior experience of Project Management - for those with no experience, CTP's 2 week APMP course will be an ideal option, as it assumes little or no knowledge; see the water or which the formore information.



Programme Structure

This course is delivered in 2 modules lasting 5 days each. There is a break of 3 weeks between each module to allow for examination results for PRINCE2 to be processed.

*Candidates must pass the PRINCE2 Practitioners exam before attending Module 2.

IODULE 1

The aim of both the PRINCE2 Foundation and Practitioner elements of the programme are to introduce students to the characteristics and contexts of a project, and the principles, processes and themes of the PRINCE 2 methodology.

The Practitioner element allows students to then apply and tailor the methodology to a project situation.

Exams take place on Day 2 (Foundation) and Day 5 (Practitioner) of the course.

MODULE 2

The APM Project Management Qualification for PRINCE2® Practitioners course follows the syllabus provided by APM, which is built around the APM Body of Knowledge 6th edition. The course provides delegates with a detailed understanding of the underpinning tools, techniques and principles that are fundamental to successful project delivery.

The course is intensive and therefore delegates are expected to undertake revision work in the evening to prepare for the examination that will be taken at the end of the course.

Key exam information for module 2:

This is a closed book, 2 hour exam, comprising six essay-based questions to be selected from a total of ten. Each is worth 50 marks, and candidates are required to achieve a minimum of 165 marks out of 300 (55%) to pass.

What Study Support will I Receive?

All pre course study material is provided along with all books and notes for the classroom. Support is provided throughout the course by the tutor.
