Who is the course for?

This course is for Service leavers who are looking at careers in project or general management but who have little or no experience of that. Attendees will gain the understanding of commercial terminology needed to succeed at interview and in a commercial role.



Note: Service leavers attending this course should be literate and numerate to at least Level 2.
