

Reservist Employment Support (RES) Trial FAQs V7.2

Issued by SO2 Resettlement Policy & Plans, TESRR, MOD

1.	What employment support is being offered to Reservists?	The trial is designed to provide employment support to unemployed reservists or employed reservists who are in receipt of a redundancy notice plus FTRS (with less than 6 years service) and ADC commitment personnel who will remain in the volunteer reserve on completion of their commitments. 2. 3.	As a reservist will the CTP help me if I am in employment but wish to change my job?	Only if you are in receipt of a redundancy notice in your current job.	Active						

4.	How will reservists register for the CTP?	Eligible reservists will apply for the trial through a nominated point of contact in their normal reserve unit. Each Service will issue further details of the nominated points of contact within units. Each Service has a central Single Point of Contact (SPOC) responsible for the trial within their Service. 5.	How do I access the support?	Access to the support will be via a nominated unit representative (detailed by each Service) who will be responsible for your access to the trial.	Active
6.	When will the support be delivered?	The trial will commence on 16 May 2016 and details will be distributed via the Chain of Command.	Active
7.	Do I get Travel and Subsistence for attending support sessions?	No. Travel and Subsistence is not available as part of this trial.	Active
8.	Am I on duty when attending trial support sessions?	Yes, you will be classed as on duty under Category C-2 (Training of Restricted Value (Voluntarily unpaid)), when attending support sessions.	Active
9.	Do I get paid as part of my Man Training Days (MTDs) for attending support sessions?	No, you will not get paid as part of your Man Training Days for attending support sessions.	Active
10.	Does attendance at the support sessions count towards my MTDs?	No, attendance at the support sessions will not count towards Man Training Days.	Active
11.	What financial support or training grants are available within the CTP support?	There is no financial support or training grant available within the CTP support.	Active
12.	When does the support end?	Eligibility for reservist employment support ceases upon any of the following conditions being met, whichever is the earliest: a. The reservist has had access to the support for a period of 12 months. b. The reservist gains employment (whether under the assistance provided	Active

		under this programme or elsewhere). c. The reservist is discharged from the Reserves.	
13.	Do I get employment support when I leave the Reserves?	No, you will not get employment support if you leave the Reserves. The support is only available whilst you remain serving in the reserves, if you meet the eligibility criteria.	Active
14.	What if I am injured during my reserve service, can I get employment support help?	Reservists who are unable to return to their normal civilian employment owing to an attributable injury or illness caused during, or as a result of their duty reservist employment will be eligible for the trial.	Active
15.	I am an Ex Regular volunteer reservist who is unemployed – can I access the employment support on this trial?	If your date of regular discharge is LESS than 2 years ago at the point you need support, then you remain entitled to the 2 year post-discharge support offered as part of your previous regular resettlement entitlement and you must continue to use the CTP 2 year post discharge support. If your date of regular discharge is MORE than 2 years ago, then you can apply for the RES trial support.	Active
16.	I am an Ex Regular on an FTRS commitment which is ending, but I am remaining in the volunteer reserves – can I access the employment support on this trial?	If your date of regular discharge is LESS than 2 years ago at the point you need support, then you remain entitled to the 2 year post-discharge support offered as part of your previous regular resettlement entitlement and you must continue to use the CTP 2 year post discharge support. If your date of regular discharge is MORE than 2 years ago, AND you have less than 6 years aggregated FTRS LoS, then you can apply for the RES trial support.	Active
