Regional Overview

This region covers the geographical area that includes; Cornwall, Devon, Dorset, Somerset, Wiltshire, Hampshire (West), Gloucestershire, Herefordshire and South Wales.

The region has the highest percentage of rural land of any English region, three quarters of the total land area being agricultural. The largest city is Bristol. Other major urban centres include Plymouth, Swindon, Gloucester, Exeter, Bath, and the South East Dorset conurbation of Bournemouth, Poole and Christchurch. The most economically productive areas are Bristol, the M4 corridor and South East Dorset which are all areas with the best links to London.

South Wales is made up of Pembrokeshire, Carmarthenshire, Swansea and Neath Port Talbot, Bridgend, Rhondda Cynon Taf, Merthyr Tydfil, Caerphilly, Blaenau Gwent, Torfaen, Vale of Glamorgan, Monmouthshire, Newport and Cardiff.

The areas of highest job density are centered around Cardiff, and along the M4 motorway that runs through Newport, Cardiff and on to Swansea.

The major urban areas are Cardiff, Swansea and Newport. Cardiff and the wider Vale of Glamorgan are the significant economic areas in South East Wales. Cardiff city relies principally on the retail, finance, media and tourism sectors and has experienced major regeneration particularly in the city centre and around Cardiff Bay.

Each of these areas has its own varying set of employment factors which you need to take into account when job searching. Therefore, it is beneficial for you to keep up-to-date with

Dozens of jobs EE/BT jobs to be created in Plymouth



Dozens of jobs could be created in Plymouth following the merger between mobile operator EE and BT. The telecoms giant said the city will be one of the areas to benefit from the creation of 600 new customer service roles in the UK and Ireland. BHS not facing immediate job cuts, says business minister



There are no plans to make immediate redundancies at high street chain BHS, business minister Anna Soubry has said. "The clear message is that BHS is still open for business as usual. There are no plans for immediate redundancies or store closures," she told MPs. Ms Soubry's urgent statement in the House of Commons came after BHS went into administration, putting 164 shops and almost 11,000 jobs at risk. Administrators will now try to sell all or part of the 88-year old retailer. The department store is expected to continue to trade in the meantime. [Read more](#)

Devolution deal proposed to boost the West of England economy



Leaders of the West of England councils, the Mayor of Bristol and the Government have negotiated the proposed agreement seeking to devolve significant powers, funding and responsibilities to the region. Negotiations have also been supported by the West of England Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP).

This agreement will go to all four councils for consideration, who will then make a decision on how to proceed. The move would represent a major change, bringing decisions on transport, investment, funding, skills training, business support, housing and strategic planning to the West of England and away from central government.

The West of England is the most productive city region outside of London, with a number of flourishing sectors, including: creative, health, advanced engineering, aerospace, food and drink, business services such as legal, property and insurance and a growing "low carbon" technologies and

services industry. The deal could mean a significant boost to economic growth and prosperity for businesses and citizens. [Read more](#)
