NEBOSH Certificate in Environmental Management

- ✓ Two thirds of Health and Safety roles include Environmental Management responsibilities
- ✓ 2014 NEBOSH survey found that over 97% of students would recommend the qualifications to others
- ✓ Recognised by the Chartered Institution of Water and Environmental Management as meeting the requirements for technical membership (TechCIWEM)

Who is the course for?

- The course is suitable for all Service leavers, but is particularly suitable for those with supervisory experience or responsibilities in a Health and Safety environment.
- Previous environmental management experience is not required.



• Aimed at managers, supervisors and employees with responsibility for managing environmental issues in their day to day work.

Course Structure

The course covers the practical issues involved in the management of environmental risk. Based on best practice and international industry standards, the syllabus takes a risk management approach to the subject.

The course includes:



- Environmental Management Systems and Impact Assessments
- Sources and use of energy and energy efficiency
- Control of pollution
- Planning for and dealing with environmental emergencies

The course is assessed via 2 units:

EC1: Management and Control of Environment Hazards (Two hour written exam)

EC2: Environmental Practical Application

What support will I receive?

The course will be 6 days of classroom based learning supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course.

All students are issued with a copy of the supporting textbook 'RRC International NEBOSH Certificate in Environmental Management'

Course Fees and How to Fund

This course is Non-Contract funded and Service leavers are therefore required to fund the course before attendance.

CTP offers a range of NEBOSH courses to suit an individual's employment needs. These individual courses can be combined as required and put on one ELCAS Claim Authorisation Note (CAN) as permitted by MOD policy. This has TESRR approval for those in resettlement.
