NI science park expansion 'to create 5,000 new jobs'



The Northern Ireland Science Park will create 5,000 new jobs as part of a £100m expansion over the next 10 years.

The Science Park, which will rebrand as Catalyst, will expand eventually to an area of a million square feet.

Three new buildings will be constructed, with two of those going on a site in Londonderry, with strong cross-border connections and another being built on the existing site in Belfast.

Catalyst Inc is a not-for-profit organisation that has nine sites across Northern Ireland and Co Donegal

Private sector growth slows



Growth in Northern Ireland's private sector has slowed, according to economic analysis by Ulster Bank.

The Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) monitors certain indicators, such as employment levels and new business order, on a monthly basis.

While new orders remain broadly unchanged, job creation has increased at a lower rate in the last month and according to Richard Ramsey, Ulster Bank's chief economist there has been a "significant slowdown".

Domino's Pizza to create 400 NI jobs ahead of Euros



Domino's Pizza is set to create 10,000 new jobs due to expected demand around the Euros - with 400 of them to be in Northern Ireland.

The major recruitment drive is part of plans to open more than 65 stores across the UK and Ireland this year.

The company is braced for an upsurge in demand and expects three pizzas to be ordered every second during Euro 2016.

Bombardier announces losses of almost £200m



Bombardier has announced an operating loss last year of almost £200m – mainly because of problems with its C Series programme.

The aerospace firm said the downturn in 2015 wiped out all the profit it had made this decade and represented one of its worst ever financial periods.

Bombardier, who employs around 5,000 people, also admitted it was facing an uphill task winning new contracts because of a lack of new aircraft programmes around the world.
