Course Structure

The course covers the practical issues involved in the management of Construction hazards and risk control. Based on best practice and international industry standards, the syllabus takes a risk management approach to the subject.

The course includes:



- ✓ Construction Law and Management
- ✓ Construction sites
- ✓ Vehicle and plant movement
- ✓ Musculoskeletal hazards
- ✓ Work equipment
- ✓ Electrical safety and Fire Safety
- ✓ Chemical and biological , Physical and physiological health
- ✓ Working at Height
- ✓ Excavation work and confined spaces
- ✓ Demolition and deconstruction
