250 jobs to go at manufacturer as JLR contract ends



INDUSTRIAL group GKN is cutting 40% of its workforce in Telford after failing to fill the gap left by a Jaguar Land Rover (JLR) contract that had come to an end. 251 jobs are being lost, which the union Unite has described as a "body blow" to the local economy. It said the loss of these jobs had been on the cards since last December, as the contracts for building the Defender chassis platforms for came to an end, but the union said it was disappointed that GKN had not secured more contracts to keep the highly-skilled workforce in <u>Read more</u>

2.1bn deal secured to support Coningsby Typhoon fleet



A £2.1 billion 10-year partnership has been secured by BAE Systems to support the RAF Coningsby Typhoon fleet, sustaining hundreds of high skills jobs. The partnership with the Ministry of Defence (MOD) will see them working with the Royal Air Force (RAF) and Leonardo-Finmeccanica to support the UK Typhoon fleet. The arrangement will introduce new ways of working to further reduce the costs of operating the fleet at RAF Coningsby and RAF Lossiemouth by more than a third. **Read more**

500 new jobs to rejuvenate Thoresby Colliery site



About 500 new jobs could be created on the site of Thoresby Colliery as part of a regeneration project that has now been revealed to the public. They would be part of a 25-acre business park that will replace employment lost when Nottinghamshire's last working mine closed in July 2015. Harworth Estates, which now owns the freehold of the site, also wants to build 800 homes, create a 350-acre country park, 12 acres of sports pitches and a five-acre school as part of the project. <u>Read more</u>

Hills bought France's largest number plate manufacturer Faab Fabricauto at the end of 2015, more than doubling the size of the group which now has more than 200 employees and annual sales of around £40m. Rolls Royce profits plunge by 80%



Rolls-Royce has endured a torrid first half of 2016. New results released this morning reveal.

The manufacturing giant's profits dropped by 80% to £104m for the first half 2016. However, this did beat analyst forecasts that it would be £16m in the red.

On an unadjusted basis, the engine maker suffered a pre-tax loss of $\pounds 2.15$ bn in the six months to June due to a large one off financing cost.

The firm said it was laying off 400 people this year - 200 more than previously announced. **<u>Read More</u>**
