Great Yarmouth-based 3sun eyes brighter future after move into renewables



Rock-bottom oil and gas prices have stripped away available offshore contracts, forcing the managing director of Great Yarmouth-based 3sun to cut jobs and fight for every piece of work. Offshore renewables contracts for the region's burgeoning windfarms are coming through, and Brexit has provided a surprise boost. Increasing market share in inspections has helped the business climb back to its pre-oil and gas downturn levels, with 310 staff members on the books, up from about 280 during the worst of the downturn. Brandon-based Omar Group unveils factory extension and 80 new jobs



One of the region's fastest-growing companies has toasted a brighter future as it opened a factory extension which will support 80 new jobs – just seven years after it filed for administration. The turnaround of Omar Group has already seen Brandon's biggest employer treble its workforce as the company capitalises on growing demand for its park homes and leisure lodges. "We now employ 367 people – and plan to employ another 80 – who believe in their products as being best in class."

Bedfordshire company bids for contract to upgrade British Army tanks



Lockheed Martin UK is to bid for the Ministry of Defence's contract to upgrade the British Army's Challenger 2 tanks. In collaboration with Elbit Systems UK, the Ampthill-based business will submit a proposal to undertake the Life Extension Project (LEP) that will see the main battle tanks in service until 2035.Lockheed Martin UK is a contractor for the Warrior Capability Sustainment Programme, which is upgrading a minimum of 380 armoured fighting vehicles for the Army. The company is also designing and delivering 245 turrets for the AJAX vehicles that are being produced by General Dynamics UK. Read more.

100 new jobs for Norwich as Amazon primed to open logistics centre



Amazon UK will be opening a site in the city this September with the potential to create 100 jobs. The facility will be at an industrial unit on the Sweet Briar Industrial Estate. Amazon have said it will create 30 direct jobs as well as a number of indirect jobs for roles including delivery drivers and security guards through contractors. Currently 120 drivers have been delivering for Amazon in the region however this will go up to 180. Jamie Stephenson, UK director for Amazon Logistics, said: "Amazon Logistics adds capacity and flexibility to Amazon's delivery network, enabling us to meet the delivery needs of customers. "Amazon Logistics is also helping independent local delivery companies to grow their businesses by providing state of the art technology to deliver Amazon orders." An Amazon spokesman said the centre would be a hub where a network of delivery companies would collect loads to be taken elsewhere and would not be on the scale of the companies warehouses. £8m investment in Norwich 'luxury' care home will create up to 80 jobs



St John's House care home is poised to open its doors at the start of October and the director of parent company Castlemeadow Care Group has promised it will provide luxury care to its residents. Dr Sanjay Kaushal said: "With our care home in Norwich we are challenging the normal care home model, taking it to the next level. "It is not just about you staying in your room but having the opportunity to engage with other residents. In the communal areas we will always have activities." The 60-bed facility will be on Heigham Road and Dr Kaushal said there would be between 65 and 80 jobs on the site. Read more.

Aldi Chelmsford and Essex expansion plan sees more than 20 new jobs created



Aldi are searching for more than 20 new recruits for its regional distribution centre in Chelmsford.

The supermarket chain, who have a store on Springfield Road and are set to bring a second supermarket to the city on the old Britvic factory site in Westway, will take on new staff as part of its expansion plan for the area. Graham Hetherington, regional managing director at Aldi, said: "Our Chelmsford distribution centre supports all of our stores in the south east of England, and with a rapid increase in the number of Aldi stores in the area, we require significant support for our warehouse to facilitate this growth. "We're looking to attract applicants from a range of backgrounds and sectors including supermarket, fast-food and clothing chains, with relevant experience in retail, and the skills to succeed in a fast-paced environment." Energy company sets sights on expanding its workforce by 150



Flow Energy, which is based at Felaw Maltings business centre on the town's waterfront, is one of a number of smaller suppliers which are now knocking at the door of the energy "big six", as more customers turn to other companies with the opening up of energy markets. The £100m turnover firm arrived in Ipswich four years ago and has grown rapidly from a team of just three to around 190 staff, most of whom have been recruited locally. A recent deal with Shell Energy Europe, through which it buys its energy thereby increasing its purchasing power, has enabled it to target sustainable growth, explained managing director Andrew Beasley.
