Global giant bids £243m for parcel company



Postal giant Deutsche Post DHL has had a £242.7m bid for UK Mail Group accepted by the Coventry company's board. UNSWIS - Work attachments for Medical Discharge Service leavers (UK)



Universities in Support of Wounded, Injured and Sick Service Personnel (UNSWIS) was established in 2012, and has grown to a network of 46 Universities across the UK providing short unpaid work placements, taster visits, open days and education and training advice for wounded, injured and sick (WIS) personnel, Veterans and their families to assist them in their transition to civilian employment.

Before UNSWIS, there were no formal partnerships with universities designed to support rehabilitation and resettlement of WIS personnel through work experience placements. Universities are a major contributor to the UK economy.

500 new jobs to rejuvenate Thoresby Colliery site

Harworth Estates, which now owns the freehold of the site, also wants to build 800 homes, create a 350-acre country park, 12 acres of sports pitches and a five-acre school as part of the project. Midlands Top 500 Companies Revealed



Retail, manufacturing and property giants dominate the summit of the latest Insider Top 500, which ranks organisations by a combination of their turnover and profitability.

Insider's 2016 Top 500 has a collective turnover of £223.6bn - a significant hike of £21bn on 2015. Combined pre-tax profits also rose to £14bn from £11bn, an increase of more than 10 per cent.

However, the figures are skewed towards the larger entities, with the table's top ten accounting for a quarter of the turnover figure.

There were also 76 new entries to the rankings this year, including reigning Premier League champions Leicester City FC (166) and Belfield Furnishings (427), which underwent a private equity-backed management buyout in July. Read more

Amazon is to create 4,500 temporary jobs at its Rugeley site, quadupling the number of people working there in the run-up to Christmas. The online business is looking for 20,000 people across the UK to deal with the Christmas period. John Tagawa, Amazon's Vice-President of UK Operations, said: "The thousands of seasonal associates who join us at this time each year play an integral role in helping us deliver an exceptional experience for our customers during the Christmas season."
