Future for Heroes is a free residential course for Service leavers built around four main parts: Finding out about yourself, planning your life, finding a purpose & setting objectives, and making a personal commitment to the future.

Participants achieve a deeper understanding of yourself, techniques to strengthen your areas of weakness, an awareness of new aptitudes and talents, the ability to harness your abilities for your new life, an understanding of the relevance of the qualities, skills and qualifications gained in the Forces, and coping mechanisms to manage stress and recognise its causes, symptoms and effects.

At the conclusion of the Future for Heroes course the Candidates will have awoken old skills and coping strategies, as well as completed a personal development plan with their mentor.
