Jet2 to create 50 new jobs in Belfast



The airline Jet2 has announced the creation of 50 new jobs in Northern Ireland. The company, which is based at Belfast International Airport, is looking to recruit for a variety of Pilots, Cabin Crew and Engineering positions. It comes as part of a UKwide recruitment drive which will see Jet2 increase its workforce by 1,000 people. Jet2 is the fourth largest registered airline in the United Kingdom and flies to 17 destinations from Belfast International. <u>Read more</u>

Limivady firm lands US veterans contract



A Limivady-based company has agreed a deal to supply the US Veterans Administration (VA) with therapeutic chairs. Sometimes called the 'world's largest healthcare system', the VA serves nearly 9 million Army Veterans across 1,233 facilities each year.

Martin Tierney, Managing Director described it as "an absolute honour" to supply the seating to "enhance the lives of Veterans through the VA".

The seats were the product of a two-year research collaboration with specialists at Ulster University.

Telecommunications firm to create 94 new jobs in Belfast

Almost 100 new jobs are being created by a telecommunications firm in Belfast.

Metaswitch Networks is investing in a new centre in the city, will take on 25 members of staff over the next four months, and it plans to grow to 94 jobs over the coming three years. The positions on offer include roles in ICT, and research and development, with an average salary of over £27,500. Economy Minister Simon Hamilton said the project will contribute around £3.3m to the local economy once fully operational. The Minister went on: "The new centre will deliver a competitive and innovative edge to the company's operations, helping it to compete in a global industry."

Markets area £55m development given the green light in Belfast

Belfast City Council has given the go-ahead to a £55m development in the Markets area.

Residents had voiced objections over privacy and the potential for blocking light, but the East Bridge Street development will go ahead, with the council saying it has the potential to create 2,500 jobs.

"The quality of public space will be improved with the creation of a central landscaped plaza which will be accessed from Stewart Street and East Bridge Street," said Councillor Peter Johnson, Chair of the Planning Committee.

Gregg's opens fourth shop in Belfast



Bakery chain Greggs has opened its fourth shop in Belfast, creating 18 new jobs.

The new store is located at Castle Lane, one of the city's busiest shopping thoroughfares.

The chain first entered the Northern Ireland market in 2015, with a franchised shop at the M2 Applegreen station.

This was followed by a further two franchised shop openings in partnership with Applegreen on the A26 outside Ballymena and on the M1, near Lisburn.

It opened its first company-managed store at Boucher Retail Park in March this year, followed by one in the City Centre at Royal Avenue in May and then Dargan Road in the North of the City. <u>Read more</u>

Hillsborough set for £60m golf resort and Hotel



A new £60 million hotel and golf resort is to be built on farmland near Hillsborough.

Lisburn and Castlereagh Council has given the go-ahead for the project, which also includes a housing development, despite planners recommending that part of the project should be refused permission - a 200 acre patch of land on the opposite side of the A1 from the village, that is set to be transformed into a luxury golfing destination.

It has been estimated the resort could bring £10m into the local economy and could create several hundred jobs. **<u>Read more</u>**

Newry firm to create 47 new jobs



A Newry firm will create a total of 47 new jobs in a £2m investment. Critical Power Systems is a new manufacturing business that designs, creates and supplies power distribution units for the data centre market.

The creation of the jobs will come about with Invest NI contributing £345,000. Of the 47 jobs, 18 are already in place.

Accountancy firm creates 43 new jobs in Belfast expansion



Accountancy and business advisory firm BDO is creating up to 43 new jobs as part of an expansion in Belfast over the next three years.

BDO Northern Ireland beat stiff international competition to secure a lucrative contract for UK and Global Outsourcing services.

Invest NI has offered BDO \pounds 217,935 to support the recruitment of 36 of the 43 new jobs, as well as the company's training activities.

The practice employs more than 170 people in Northern Ireland and provides professional services to more than 1,000 local companies.

The new roles will provide professional services to a range of blue chip and FTSE 500 clients within the BDO International network. Twelve of the posts have already been filled. <u>Read more</u>
