#### Mick George lands £10.5m Ouse Washes project



New business has been flooding in at Mick George recently, but the building services firm has now landed a £10.5m earthworks contract where its staff will be endeavoring to keep the waters back. The company has been working on behalf of civil engineering firm JacksonHyder raising the flood banks at the Ouse Washes reservoir, which spans Cambridgeshire and Norfolk. It is sub-contracting from JacksonHyder on the project, which is part of a £27m development. Read more.

#### 116 jobs will be created in £35m scheme to expand production at Copella



Plans to invest £35m over 10 years in expanding capacity at the Copella fruit juice site near Sudbury are "a massive vote of confidence in south Suffolk", according to the firm behind the proposals. Phil Clark was speaking following a consultation into the proposals to build new can and plastic (PET) bottle lines, as well as an area for cider processing. He said the company's proposals to add cider production alongside juice manufacture, which includes the Copella brand, would not only secure those jobs but create 116 well-paid roles in operations, logistics and engineering. #### Offshore firm Gardline bought by Dutch company Boskalis



Offshore services group Gardline has been snapped up by a Dutch company in a multi-million pound deal, ending nearly 50 years as a family business. Dredging and marine experts Boskalis has paid around £40m, including taking on company debt, for the surveying contractor. Gardline currently employs around 750 employees, including a pool of 100 surveyors, and as well as its principal offices in Great Yarmouth has activities in the USA, Brazil and Singapore. **Read more.** 



## Dozens of engineering jobs created ahead of new Northampton engine test centre



The proposed new MAHLE Powertrain technology centre in St James' Mill Road, off Weedon Road, has led to a recruitment drive for dozens of new engineers, technicians and apprentices in the town. The Centre will be built with an atmospheric chamber to test how engines perform in different conditions and can simulate how a car would perform at altitudes of up to 5,000 meters. Ahead of the site's completion, which is scheduled for mid-2018, MAHLE is also hosting a recruitment open day on September 17. **Read more.** 

#### Number of out-of-work claimants in Peterborough drops by two per cent



The number of people claiming out-of-work benefits in Peterborough has fallen by two per cent over the last year. Figures released by the Department of Work and Pensions show the number of Universal Credit claimants dropped to 1,770 people last month for the Peterborough local authority area. It is a fall of 45 people from the same month last year. Over the same period, the number of 18 to 24-year-old claimants rose by two per cent to 440 from 430. Read more.

#### Housing Minister praises Ibstock's £50m factory investment



Housing and Planning Minister Alok Sharma has welcomed plans by Ibstock, the UK's biggest brick manufacturer, to invest £50 million in a new factory in Leicestershire. Ibstock is building a 100 million capacity brick plant at its Leicestershire headquarters in the village of the same name. The company expects to start commissioning the plant in the final quarter of this year. The move will expand the company's UK brick capacity by around 13 per cent when in full production. # Car manufacturer set to open £6million Daventry state-of-the-art apprentice training facility



Volvo has begun training staff members at its new £6million Daventry facility where, in 2020, it intends to accommodate hundreds of apprentices as part of an ongoing recruitment drive. The building on Prospect Way will officially open its doors when the final construction work finishes in early October, but it has been used for training since mid-August, a year after the multimillion investment was announced. As one of the key sectors in Lincolnshire's economy, leading lights from the manufacturing industry came together to discuss the county's place on the world stage. The Greater Lincolnshire Manufacturing Conference was held at the Isaac Newton building at the University of Lincoln on Friday September 15 and was run by Business Lincolnshire and Natwest. **Read more.** 

## New Anglia LEP's new economic strategy aims to generate 88,000 jobs by 2036



An ambitious vision to create 88,000 jobs, boost the Norfolk and Suffolk's economy by £17.5bn and encourage 30,000 new businesses has been unveiled. New Anglia Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP) is asking partners to back its economic strategy which aims to bolster our region's economy over the next 19 years. To do this the proposal will target eight areas, identified as providing the "greatest opportunities and commitment for continued growth", including Norwich and the "energy coast". Read more.



#### Marshall Group and Hill to deliver hundreds of new Cambridge homes



Two of Cambridge's leading family-owned businesses, Marshall Group Properties, part of the Marshall Group – one of the largest private employers in Cambridge – and Hill, a top 15 UK housebuilder, have announced a strategic 50:50 joint venture agreement that will see them deliver 450 new homes in Cambridge. The new development, Wing, will sit on a 160-acre parcel of land owned by the Marshall Group and is the business' first major residential development project. Read more.
