Boots to cut 4,000 jobs and close 48 opticians



Health and beauty retailer Boots is to cut more than 4,000 jobs as it deals with the impact of coronavirus.

Parent company Walgreens Boots Alliance said the move will affect seven per cent of the workforce.

It plans to close 48 Boots Opticians stores and has outlined a 20 per cent staff reduction in its UK support office in Nottingham.

Plans for new concrete plant at Ipswich Docks submitted



Plans to build a concrete plant by the River Orwell have been submitted to Suffolk County Council.

The plans, submitted by Brett Concrete, are for a half acre site towards the north end of the West Bank Terminal of Ipswich Docks and include a nearly 13m tall cement silo. It would employ six local people – one site operator and five mixer lorry drivers. The plant would produce ready-mix concrete for construction projects in and to the east of Ipswich. **Read more**

Plans for new offices and retail space in seaside town going ahead



Community leaders in Southwold are pressing ahead with a multi-million-pound project to demolish several buildings in the town to make way for new office and retail units.

The coronavirus lockdown has delayed work on the Southwold Enterprise Hub project, which could create up to 90 new jobs.

But councillor David Beavan, who has long been opposed to the plans, has branded the town council's decision to press ahead with the scheme as "callous". **Read more**

Thousands of Bedford jobs need 'reskilling' for green economy



More than 8,000 jobs in Bedford would be at risk in a shift to a green economy, new analysis suggests, with workers needing new skills and training.

But thousands of other roles could be created or would be in higher demand in an eco-friendly transition.

The study – published by council leaders' group UK100 – is calling for a "Green New Deal" to drive the recovery from the Covid-19 crisis while creating a zero-carbon society by 2050.

An estimated 8,360 workers would need "reskilling" in Bedford to adapt to more sustainable industries, according to the analysis.

That's 11 per cent of all local jobs, although that includes any new ones it predicts would be created in a green job's revolution. Read more



LEP Welcomes £43M investment in Lowestoft's Flood Defences



A £43m Government investment in Lowestoft's flood defences will unlock investment and deliver jobs, as well as protecting homes and businesses, New Anglia Local Enterprise Partnership has said.

The funding will provide tidal flood walls and a tidal barrier to protect residents and businesses in the town, removing the risk that for years has held Lowestoft back in terms of economic growth. Read more

Norfolk-based offshore teams awarded London Array Wind Farm contract



Technicians at the Great Yarmouth operation of Worley (formerly 3sun Group) will deliver the work on the 175-turbine wind farm about 20 km off the Kent coast. The wind farm generates enough energy to power more than 470,000 homes and displace more 900,000 tonnes of CO2 a year – the equivalent to removing 300,000 cars from the road each year.

Worley teams - currently inspecting more than 70% of the UK's offshore wind turbines and installed over 4,000 in the past 10 years - were among the first working on London Array in Phase 1 of the project in 2012.

Alex Baker, operations director for Worley's Great Yarmouth offshore wind energy operations, said: "This new contract furthers the long-standing relationship we have with SGRE.

"Our highly skilled and experienced inspection teams repeatedly demonstrate their understanding of our client's expectations, safety culture and policies, and I am positive that we will deliver to SGRE to the same high standard they are used to with our teams." Read more
