40M Green Jobs Challenge Fund Announced



Plans to create thousands of new jobs to kick-start the nation's green recovery from the coronavirus pandemic were unveiled by the government today.

The £40m Green Recovery Challenge Fund will bring forward funding to help charities and environmental organisations start work on projects across England to restore nature and tackle climate change.

The fund will help conservation organisations and their suppliers create up to 3,000 jobs and safeguard up to 2,000 others in areas such as protecting species, finding nature-based solutions to tackling climate change, conservation rangers and connecting people with the outdoors.

Aldi unveils 18 Hampshire locations in store expansion plans



SUPERMARKET giant Aldi has announced that it is on the hunt for new store locations across Hampshire towns and cities, potentially creating around 500 new jobs across the county.

The German retailer is on the lookout for a variety of sites, including opening in some places for the first time as well as adding to existing stores in places like Southampton and Eastleigh.

The UK's fifth largest supermarket has been on an expansion drive in recent years as it targets having 1,200 stores open by 2025. [Read more](#)

Government announces £10M for small businesses to kickstart tourism



Communities that depend on tourism will receive a major boost from a new £10m Kick-starting Tourism Package, the Minister for Regional Growth and Local Government Simon Clarke MP has announced. Speaking at the Local Government Association's annual conference, Minister Clarke confirmed the new funding will be distributed to communities immediately to kick start tourism in time for the summer as part of the government's drive to boost the recovery of the economy.

This is the latest package of support for economic recovery following the Prime Minister's announcement of the "New Deal" earlier this week, which will bring forward £5bn of capital investment projects, supporting jobs and economic recovery. [Read more](#)

Work will start this summer on building a new 120,000sq ft manufacturing facility for Bio Pure Technologies Ltd - a fluid-path component manufacturer for the biotechnology industry, which will see 120 jobs created.

£85 million secured in the South East – Projects to energise the economy and prompt recovery!



The South East Local Enterprise Partnership (SELEP) has secured £85 million from the new Getting Building Fund announced by Government, which sought 'shovel-ready' schemes that would provide much-needed jobs, growth and the groundwork for further investment at this critical time. Government's new £900 million Getting Building Fund has been set up to invest in local infrastructure projects to drive economic growth in the wake of the COVID-19 crisis. SELEP successfully secured the largest value for any LEP area in the UK from the fund. The £85 million will be used for several different projects across East Sussex, Essex, Kent, Medway, Southend and Thurrock, focusing on areas and industries that have been hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic as well as those sectors that will provide the most help for the economy to bounce back. Kickstart Jobs scheme "for young people"



A £2bn Kickstart scheme will subsidise six-month work placements for people on Universal Credit aged between 16 and 24, who are at risk of long-term unemployment. For each "kickstarter" job, the government will cover the cost of 25 hours' work a week at the National Minimum Wage - £4.55 for under 18s, £6.45 for 18 to 20-year-olds, and £8.20 for 21 to 24-year-olds.

Employers will be able to top up that payment if they wish.

The government said it would allow young people "the opportunity to build their skills in the workplace, and to gain experience that will improve their chances of going on to find long-term sustainable work". The scheme will open for applications in August, with the first jobs expected to start in the autumn and run until December 2021 - with the option of being extended. [Read more](#)

700 new homes, and 1,000 new jobs in Southampton



PLANS to build more than 700 homes across Southampton have been given the green light.

City councillors have approved plans for 726 affordable homes in the city as part of a £144m investment. The investment is set to create 1,089 jobs and it is part of the 1,000 council homes Programme pledged by Labour councillors in 2018. [Read more](#)

BRITE future for greater Brighton businesses after £10 million growth programme launched.



The University of Brighton has partnered with Plus X to deliver a growth and innovation programme to support businesses across the Greater Brighton region.

Over three years, the Brighton Research Innovation Technology Exchange (BRITE) programme will bring £10.5m worth of support to more than a hundred small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) to scale, accessing business growth expertise and world-class product development facilities.

BRITE will be located at the brand new Plus X Brighton innovation hub which is located next to the University of Brighton's Moulsecoomb campus and designed to help business and communities collaborate, innovate and grow. [Read more](#)

Hermes to create 10,000 new jobs across the UK



Delivery company Hermes is to create more than 10,000 new jobs in the UK as it invests £100 million to meet the demand from 'stay-at-home' shoppers. Hermes said it is dealing with a 'massive spike' in online shopping caused by the [coronavirus](#) lockdown.

It will take on about 1,500 new full-time staff, including workers at its Yorkshire head office, warehouse staff, and drivers.

It will also create another 9,000 opportunities for self-employed couriers up and down the country. Details of the locations have not yet been revealed. [Read more](#)
