A Cutting edge manufacturing park is set to welcome an extra 175 jobs to Teesside from a new green energy project, according to a regeneration chief. The £55m Tees Advanced Manufacturing Park (Tees AMP), near Newport Bridge, was launched with money from Middlesbrough Council, the Tees Valley Combined Authority (TVCA), the SSI task force and private investment. 200 jobs created by North East energy firms who are expanding in lockdown



Around 200 North East jobs are being created by a pair of fast-growing energy businesses which are revealing expansion plans in lockdown. Global energy procurement specialist Northern Gas and Power is creating 150 jobs and taking four floors at Gateshead's flagship new office development, the £13m Riga building, while energy consultancy has unveiled 50 new posts across its Sunderland and South Shields bases.
