Amazon



Amazon have announced that it will have created more than 300 additional permanent roles in Scotland by the end of this year and are also recruiting for more than 2,000 seasonal positions to support their festive operations. The fulfilment centre in Dunfermline, which currently employs more than 1,000 people in permanent roles, will create a further 200 permanent roles by the end of 2020. It is also hiring for more than 1,000 seasonal roles. The fulfilment centre in Gourock is recruiting for more than 200 seasonal positions to support our festive operations. The delivery and sort centres in Bathgate, Dundee and Motherwell will have increased their permanent headcount from around 170 at the beginning of 2020, to more than 300 by the end of the year. <u>Read more.</u>

Co-op



Grocery chain the Co-op is opening 50 new stores and creating 1,000 new jobs this year. The new roles come on top of the 1,000 posts it added during lockdown as demand from shoppers increased. The extra jobs announced, will be spread across the new shops and 15 stores that are being enlarged. The Co-op said its research had found that 70% of adults have relied on their local convenience store for food and other goods in recent months. The retailer also said that it had expanded its online shop. <u>Read more</u>.

## Starbucks



A total of 75 new jobs will be created with three new Starbucks drive-thru stores set to open across Greater Glasgow. The first store on Dalmarnock Road opened in September while a further two stores are opening on Renfrew Road and at Hillington Business Park in October. Gordon Campbell, Starbucks Operations Manager at OCO Westend Ltd, said: "As part of our expansion project bringing 11 new Starbucks stores to Scotland, we are excited to open our stores in Rutherglen, Paisley, and Hillington. We look forward to welcoming customers to enjoy their favourite Starbucks food and beverages." Read more.





Young people will be guaranteed a job, education or formal training under a new Scottish government scheme. First Minister Nicola Sturgeon said the "youth guarantee" was aimed at ensuring young people do not carry the "economic scars" of coronavirus into adulthood. The £60m initiative will be backed by additional money for apprenticeships. It was announced as Ms Sturgeon set out her government's plans for the next year. Under the proposals, everyone aged between 16 and 24 in Scotland will be guaranteed "an opportunity at university or college, an apprenticeship programme, employment including work experience, or participating in a formal volunteering programme". # Scottish start-ups get funding boost



High tech start-up companies in Scotland will receive grants of up to £50,000 as part of plans to help them survive the pandemic. Scottish Government economy secretary Fiona Hyslop announced 41 start-ups with high growth potential will receive funding alongside business help. The funding will support companies in the tech and lowcarbon sectors which have seen their research impacted by lockdown. Hyslop said: "Start-up and spinout companies, many of which are in the technology, digital and low-carbon sectors, are the future of our economy. They are driven by the spirit of entrepreneurship and innovation. Crucially, they are the kind of enterprises that create high-quality jobs, and which attract investment into Scotland – both of which will be vital to successfully rebuilding the economy after the damage caused by Covid-19. **Read more.** 

#### Ben Nevis development



Ninety jobs could be created in Lochaber to construct a 50cabin, £12million luxury retreat in the shadow of Ben Nevis – with another 60 new jobs on the cards once it is built. Councillors are being asked to approve an application by Forest Holidays to build the massive development at Leanachan Forest, located west of the Nevis Range ski resort, which has attracted thousands of visitors to its slopes each year. The 77-acre site, at the foot of Ben Nevis, would accommodate 50 'eco-sensitive' timber cabins comprising of one to five bedroom properties. Officials say the project will create more than 60 full-time jobs both on location and within the local community once built, and generate up to £1million to the local economy. **Read more.**
