Recruiting a record 1250 new apprentices and graduates



More than 850 apprenticeships and 400 graduate roles are available across the UK, the highest number we have ever recruited in a single year, despite the ongoing pandemic.

Around 75% of apprenticeships and more than 50% of graduate roles are based in the North of England – providing critical employment and education opportunities in areas reliant on long-term job creation. New recruits will have the chance to be involved in some of the UK's most exciting and technologically advanced programmes including Tempest, a future combat air system for the Royal Air Force and Dreadnought, a new generation of submarines for the Royal Navy.

Plans have been announced to build Britain's biggest electric vehicle battery plant on the site where a coal-burning power station once stood - bringing 8,000 jobs to the region. Britishvolt will invest £2.6 billion in the project in Blyth, Northumberland, creating 3,000 jobs and reportedly representing the biggest investment in the North East of England since Nissan arrived in 1984.

Work to start on Quayside arena and hotel in early 2021



DEVELOPERS can press ahead with a £260 million arena complex on Gateshead Quayside, after the government decided not to have the final say on the massive project. Gateshead Council's planning committee approved plans for a 12,500-capacity arena, a conference centre and hotel last month – with the development hailed as a “world class” addition that will bring an extra 400,000 visitors and more than £60 million to the local economy each year.
