MSD create 240 new jobs in Meath



Pharmaceutical firm MSD are set to create 240 new jobs as they continue their expansion in Dunboyne.

The new manufacturing facility is expected to create an estimated 140 new jobs by 2025 and will support an innovative new approach to developing and launching MSD's future biologics medicines.

Additionally, the existing MSD Dunboyne Biologics facility expect to hire approximately 100 new employees within the coming year.

LetsGetChecked today officially announces 160 Dublin positions and an additional 50 positions internationally.

The news comes after the launch last month of LetsGetChecked's athome Coronavirus test for Irish consumers. The company has added 200 positions in Dublin so far in 2020, with the announcement today bringing their total global team to 653 employees.

The 160 new positions in Dublin will include several developer and engineer roles, as well as expanding departments such as nursing, data science, marketing, customer solutions, sales, and recruitment.

The new contracts for Tourism Northern Ireland, University of Exeter, National University of Ireland Galway, and new Irish & UK energy market entrant, Bright have further boosted growth at the agency, which currently employs over 50 staff across the three offices.

Ashley to the rescue as Frasers to replace Debenhams in Derry



Frasers Group is taking over the doomed Debenhams store at the Foyleside Centre in Derry and opening a new department store, creating 200 jobs.

Debenhams confirmed at the start of this month that it would cease trading at 124 shops, including its five in Northern Ireland, after the failure of last-ditch rescue efforts, putting 12,000 employee jobs at risk.

Since then, Mike Ashley's Frasers Group (formerly known as Sports Direct) has been in negotiations with Debenhams' administrators about a deal to save at least some of the posts in jeopardy.

Hauliers hiring dozens of dedicated customs staff to ease Brexit delays



Several larger haulage firms in Northern Ireland are scrambling to recruit dozens of dedicated customs administrators to deal solely with the new arrangements Brexit will bring. It comes amid continuing fears that they are likely to experience disruption to their business, including an inability to move goods into or out of Northern Ireland, regardless of the outcome of the current UK-EU talks.

Brexit: Up to 23,000 jobs at risk due to NI Protocol, claims report



Up to 23,000 jobs are at risk as a result of the Northern Ireland Protocol and consumer choices and prices would also be harmed by the arrangement, a report by the Department for the Economy has claimed.

The report was published on Monday but was written before last week's announcements on the protocol, agreed between the UK and EU, to avoid a hard border on the island of Ireland.

The DfE has published a separate report by Retail Economics suggesting that goods coming into NI after the transition period would bear average tariffs of nearly 11% in a no-deal Brexit.

Foster talks up chances of US firms coming to NI after Brexit



Northern Ireland will be an attractive location for US firms seeking access to EU and UK markets after Brexit, the First Minister has said.

Businesses will have unfettered access to Britain and frictionless trade with the Republic and the rest of the EU next year. That created opportunities and benefits, DUP leader Arlene Foster said.

She added: "If businesses are from America and looking for access to the UK single market and access to the EU single market, then Northern Ireland seems to be a very good place."

Several US and multinational fintech firms already have major bases here.

Executive lifeline of £7.8m wings its way to two NI airports



Belfast-headquartered Belfast International Airport has said its share of a £7.8m lifeline from the Executive will help secure jobs across its site.

Finance Minister Conor Murphy announced the support for Belfast International and Belfast City Airport - which is on top of one year of rates relief which the airports and City of Derry Airport have already received. Support to City of Derry Airport of £1.23m was announced last month.

The airports have been hit financially as planes were grounded and demand from passengers fell dramatically as a result of global lockdowns to deal with the spread of Covid-19.
