Historically, employment in the West Midlands is dominated by manufacturing. Employers such as Jaguar Land Rover and JCB continue to lead within this sector.

The eastern part of the Midlands consists of counties such as of Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire and Rutland.

£10m for Derby flood defences will support new homes and commercial space for 1,000 jobs



Derby City Council is poised to accept a £10m grant to create more homes in the city, along with commercial space that could accommodate 1,000 jobs.

Last summer, it was announced that the city would receive the Capital Flood Defence Grant in Aid funding from The Environment Agency for its Our City Our River (OCOR) project.

But a period of time was needed to establish that the grant's conditions and obligations were acceptable. Now, the council's Cabinet is set to formally accept the cash. Read more

Plans for Gigafactory at Coventry Airport take off with 'game-changing' partnership



Coventry City Council is to enter into a joint venture partnership with Coventry Airport to develop proposals for a Gigafactory which could be operational by 2025.

They will join forces to develop proposals, which could create 4,000 jobs, and submit an outline planning application for a Gigafactory at the airport in 2021.

This will take place alongside regional discussions with battery suppliers and automotive manufacturers to secure the long-term investment needed. **Read more**

Work begins on Newport Innovation Park



Work has begun on building the infrastructure for the Newport Innovation Park - which will ultimately support the creation of up to 950 jobs.

Councillors and stakeholders cut the first ground on the major project this afternoon.

The Ni-Park is a key element in the Newport Innovation and Enterprise Package, which secured £6.36m funding from the Marches Local Enterprise Partnership under the Local Growth Fund, matched by investment from Telford & Wrekin Council.

Automotive firm to create 200 jobs with £66m investment at technology park



GMIRA Technology Park has announced a new partnership that will see an engineering centre of excellence located at the site in a move that will create 200 jobs.

The partnership, with REE Automotive (REE), paves the way for the establishment of the centre, which will help accelerate its REEcorner and electric vehicle (EV) technology.

The new REE engineering centre will accelerate engineering design, validation, verification and testing of REE's products, as well as product homologation (the process by which vehicles are approved by statutory bodies). **Read more**

Israeli electric vehicle developer creating 200 UK jobs



An Israeli company that develops flat, space-saving platforms for electric cars and trucks is planning to create 200 jobs at a new \$92 million UK design headquarters.

REE Automotive is opening a global engineering centre at the Horiba MIRA vehicle technology park, near Hinckley, which will help it gear up to mass production.

The site will help it design, develop and test its new, compact electric vehicle platforms.

It will support 15 component manufacturing centres the business is creating around the world, which will eventually supply a network of vehicle manufacturers in 30 countries.

Everards brewery looking for 45 new staff



A family-owned brewery and pub business is looking for more than 45 staff members to work at its new headquarters which opens this spring.

Everards is opening a new brewery with a beer hall, shop and new offices on a 70 acre site – renamed Everards Meadows – on the southern outskirts of Leicester.

Work started on a new base near the River Soar and junction 21 of the M1, after Everards sold its previous home over the road for a £168 million extension to Fosse Park shopping centre. Read more



Go-ahead for latest phase of HS2 through West Midlands and Staffordshire



The second section of HS2 - which will carve through Staffordshire on its way from the West Midlands to Crewe - has today been given the green light.

Royal Assent has been given for Phase 2a of the budget-busting line. It comes one year after Boris Johnson signed off on the controversial scheme, which has drawn widespread criticism over spiralling costs and damage caused to the environment.

Environmental works are set to start this year, with building work beginning in 2024. It is estimated to cost around £14 billion, on top of £45bn for the first phase of the line from London to Birmingham. Read more

£35m plans to restore Elvaston Castle will create 170 jobs



Multi-million plans have been drawn up to restore and regenerate a 19th century Midlands castle and country estate.

Up to £35 million could be spent on Elvaston Castle, Derbyshire, with the construction of a new access road, the rejuvenation of dilapidated buildings and the restoration of the castle's interior.

Pending planning permission the five year project could begin as early as autumn this year. The castle is a few miles east of Derby.

Improvements would also include improved catering facilities with a new main cafe, a new adventure playground and camping facilities for caravans, motor homes and tents. Read more

A leading building supplies company will soon open a new branch in Grantham.

Eurocell will be opening the branch for tradespeople and DIYers on the Grantham Trade Park in the next few months, creating a number of jobs.
