- ◆ The course cost includes access to CompTIA Certmaster, an adaptive e-learning tool which helps to prepare for the exam. It verifies what the learner already knows through the classroom based training and identifies any knowledge gaps, focussing training on the areas needed most. Certmaster will assist learners to cover the full curriculum and test for the exam.



Further Study



This course along with prior knowledge and/or experience is sufficient to gain employment. Attendees may wish to continue training with the likes of CompTIA Penetration Testing (PenTest+) available through CTP, or CASP (Advanced Security Practitioner), but this latter course is only suitable for those with practical workplace experience. CTP also deliver a 3 day GCHQ approved Digital Forensics course

Employment Opportunities

Employment prospects are excellent in the UK, where there is a major shortage of Cyber Security skills. In 2016 as part of the National Cyber Security Strategy, the Government set aside £1.9 bn investment in Cyber Security.

Parliament issued a report on Cyber Security Skills on 16 July 2018, which stated that the gap between the demand and supply of cyber security skills is now reaching a critical level with a very limited talent pool, and the need for many roles to have security clearance. Service Leavers are an ideal talent pool for this sector
