

Driver Certificate of Professional Competence/ ADR

This 7 day course includes the DQC card—essential for driving a Large Goods Vehicle

- ✓ A Contract-Funded Level 2 qualification.
- ✓ Students gain their Driver Qualification Card (DQC), an **essential** requirement for anyone looking for employment as a driver of large goods vehicles.
- ✓ Full 35 hours of periodic Driver training as mandated by the EU's Certificate of Professional Competence requirements.
- ✓ The ADR certificate is for all existing LGV licence holders carrying goods that fall within the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulations—required by a number of transport employers.

Who is the course for?

- ◆ Students must be a current LGV Licence holder, and must have passed their LGV test prior to 10th September 2009 (or have passed their car driving test prior to January 1997).
- ◆ Note: Students who passed their LGV test after this date must complete parts 2 and 4 of their initial LGV driver training. Completion of this training will provide students with an initial Driver Qualification Card. There are a number of Preferred Suppliers who offer this training.



Course Structure

Driver CPC and ADR will cover the following in this course:



Driver CPC

- ◆ Driver health, defensive and fuel efficient driving (3.5 hours)
- ◆ Driver hours (3.5 hours)
- ◆ Digital Tachograph Rules (3.5 hours)
- ◆ Load Safety (3.5 hours)

ADR

- ◆ Core module (required by all entrants)
- ◆ Packages module
- ◆ Tanker module
- ◆ UN Classes Modules 2,3,4,5,6,8,9

Students must sit and pass a number of multiple choice examinations in order to gain their ADR certificate.

Completion of the ADR elements of the course provides students with the remaining 21 hours of Driver Training required for the completion of the CPC.

This course is classroom based and tutor led.

Employment Opportunities

Since September 2009, anyone looking to drive an LGV over 3.5 tonnes in the course of their employment is required to hold a Driver Qualification Card (DQC).

Completion of this course will provide students with the DQC and therefore open up a high number of driving and transport related opportunities.



Course Fees and How to Fund

The course is Contract-Funded. This means that no money is required for course fees, but the IRTC Grant reduces by £186.90 (7 Days IRTC).



Course Cost (7 days)	£186.90
Exam Fees	£332.10
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Total cost:	£519.00

Students who have used their IRTC allocation or are post-discharge can apply for a Standby place on the course. If offered a place via current Standby arrangements, students will pay £186.90 directly to the MoD Cashiers Office on the first day of the course.

Current exam fees are £322.10. This includes the uploading of driver hours, issue of the Driver Qualification Card, and the issue of ADR certifications. Students can use their Standard Learning Credits or the remainder of the IRTC grant to part pay their exam fees.
