## Who is the course for?

- ◆ This course is aimed at cycle enthusiasts who are seeking to work within bike retailers, as a Servicing Technician.
- ◆ There are also opportunities to work as a self employed bike mechanic.
- ◆ Attendees may also be cycling enthusiasts who may be involved in cycle coaching, cycle clubs, or organising cycle tours.



## Course Structure

### Online (approx. 2-4 weeks or 20-30 hours total)

- Attendees will have access to Google docs with extensive resources covering Modules 1 to 8 of the course content
- Multiple choice assessments
- Essay assessments
- Home working practical sessions where possible
- Regular drop in evening video calling sessions which will be optional (minimum 3 per week)
- Saturday problem solving masterclasses which will be recorded for those unable to attend live
- Direct contact with your allocated Tutor throughout the online learning.

### Workshop Training in Appleby in Westmorland, Cumbria (2 weeks)

- Two weeks of extremely intense practical onsite training and assessments
- 2:1 Student Tutor ratio enabling a very personalised learning experience
- Further practical assessments filling in the gaps from the home learning experience
- Experience of the latest technologies, both manual and electronic, including assembly, fault diagnosis from all the main manufacturers on modern bicycles
- Exposure to E-Bike systems from all major manufactures
- Exposure to advanced tooling and their correct usage
- Exposure to best workshop practices to help maintain quality of work
- Exposure to Bike Fitting, Coaching and other business ideas that protect a business from the

# What support will I receive?

- Service leavers will be assigned a Tutor who will be available to them throughout the remote learning period as well as the 2 weeks on site and beyond.
- As well as all materials being available through Google docs, there will be open session evening video calls for the group several times a week to answer any queries you may have and check progress. There will also be recorded Saturday masterclasses giving practical demonstrations.
- A Student/Tutor ratio of 2:1 during the 2 weeks onsite in Appleby
- The Bike Inn have a team of highly experienced Cycling Coaches and Trainers, Bike Fit experts, as well as a PT Instructor and Sports Psychologist who can provide advice on all aspects of cycling
- Staff at The Bike Inn are always on hand for post course support by phone or email.
