## Who is the course for?

- ◆ This course is for anyone who is a keen photographer or those who would like to understand the art of photography. You must have attended the OCN NI Level 3 Award in Photography prior to attending this course.
- ◆ Training is aimed at Service leavers who are considering a career as a photographer in any industry or those who would like to become Self Employed. Work attachments can be arranged by attendees, directly with our provider, during the course. The provider is also a commercial photography studio and delivers photography services to commercial clients.



## Course Structure

Delivered over 5 consecutive days covering:

- ✓ Monday - Introduction to Management Software and RAW processing
- ✓ Tuesday - Theory & Practical Photoshop (am), Photo Manipulation, retouching/airbrushing (pm)
- ✓ Wednesday - Theory Session (Colour Management) (am), Theory & Practical Photoshop session (pm)
- ✓ Thursday - Theory & Practical (HDR and Panorama)
- ✓ Friday - Theory & Practical photo book and online galleries. Individual tutorials and assessment

### Assessment

There are no examinations included in the assessment process. Assessment is by creation of a portfolio of evidence completed during the course. This will be done both in studio and also on location using a variety of skills. Portfolios will showcase the photography and editing skills learned on the course.

## What support will I receive?

- ◆ Training is delivered in a modern photography studio at the First Point Photography studio in Christchurch near Bournemouth where all supporting materials including IT software and hardware are available.
- ◆ You will receive 5 days face to face training as well as advice and support from the Tutor , who is also a professional commercial photographer, throughout the course.



## Further Study

This course will provide an excellent foundation for those seeking to further their career as a professional photographer. It would be ideal for those who would like to pursue a career as a self employed photographer or for those who would like to take photography as a secondary income or hobby.
