Who is the course for?

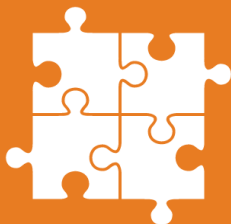

Course Structure

The course covers the practical issues involved in the management of fire safety in the workplace, and in particular the legal requirements surrounding fire safety. The course will equip attendees to undertake fire risk assessments in most low risk workplace environments

The course includes:



- ✓ Managing Fire Safety
- ✓ Principles of fire and explosion
- ✓ Fuel, oxygen and ignition sources and control measures
- ✓ Fire protection of buildings
- ✓ Safety of people in the event of fire
- ✓ Fire Safety Risk Assessment

The course is assessed via 2 units:

FSC1: Fire safety Open Book Exam (on a set national exam date)

FSC2: Practical Fire Risk Assessment (Workplace based risk assessment exam)

All attendees will undertake a closing interview to confirm their knowledge prior to obtaining their results

What support will I receive?

The course will be 4 days of classroom based learning supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course.

Attendees will undertake an inspection of fire risks in a workplace and prepare a report

All students are issued with a copy of the supporting textbook 'RRC NEBOSH National Certificate in Fire Safety'

- ◆ NEBOSH Certificates are widely recognised and are often an entry requirement for any Health and Safety roles in a workplace.
