NEBOSH General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety

A qualification for job roles with first line management responsibility for Health & Safety,

Who is the course for?

- ◆ Managers, supervisors and staff who need a broad understanding of Health and safety issues. The certificate helps individuals to manage workplace risks effectively
- ◆ The course is suitable for all Service personnel, but is particularly suitable for those with supervisory experience or responsibilities in a Health and Safety environment.
- ◆ This is a very intensive course and a large amount of self study will also be required.



Course Structure

The course provides the underpinning knowledge of Health and Safety related topics and teaches the skills and techniques through which Health and Safety procedures are implemented in the workplace. Principal subject areas include:

- ◆ The foundations, policy and organising of Health and Safety in the workplace.
- ◆ Promoting a Health and Safety culture, risk assessment and principles of control.
- ◆ Movement of people and vehicles, manual and mechanical handling.
- ◆ Work equipment, electrical, fire, construction, chemical and biological hazards
- ◆ Physical and psychological hazards, incident investigation, monitoring and review.

The course is assessed via Open Book Exam on a set date, where candidates will have 24 hours to complete and submit their scenario based exam questions and will then attend an online 'Closing Interview' to prove their subject knowledge. A practical Risk Assessment must then be submitted for marking.

What support will I receive?

- ◆ A 12 day classroom based course supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course. Students must be prepared to self study alongside the tutor led course.
- ◆ All students are issued with the textbook An Introduction to Health and Safety at Work (latest edition) as a handbook.
- ◆ In addition, the companion revision guide will be issued on a loan basis for the course duration to assist with exam preparation.
