## NVQ Assessor

## Who is the course for?

- ◆ This course is designed for Service leavers wishing for a career in the training industry.
- ◆ The course is open to all Service personnel; however a minimum Level 2 numeracy and literacy would be advantageous and a good working knowledge of IT.



## Programme Structure

Service leavers completing the course will gain:

- ◆ The NVQ Assessors qualification— a Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment.
- ◆ The course will encourage trainees to assess students while they are working through observation, questioning, and interviewing those around the student.
- ◆ Each candidate will be provided with a portfolio containing sample documentation relating directly to the awarding body standards. Throughout the duration of the programme every candidate's portfolio will be sampled by the internal verifier.



## What Study Support will I Receive?

- ◆ A 5 day course with classroom based learning supplemented by directed study and background preparatory reading during the course.
- ◆ There will be significant evening homework required. This is a level 3 course therefore there is significant out of hours study time required.
- ◆ You will be provided with experienced and qualified trainers who will help you through every step of this industry recognised qualification.

## Employment Opportunities

Opportunities exist as an assessor/tutor in all occupational areas where vocational qualifications exist, for example construction, care, catering, engineering, retail and hairdressing. Employment can also be held at a training provider or as an in-house assessor for a large organisation where staff complete vocational qualifications.

You would be required to hold a qualification at level 3 or above in the area of work you wish to assess.

The course is Non-Contract Funded and therefore the cost of the course is to be **paid direct to the Course Booking & Information Centre** in advance as soon as possible after course booking or your place may be re-allocated. Payment is to be made by credit/debit card over the phone.
